

MINORITIES IN CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM

Join the Construction Laborers' Union Work on a Jersey City High Rise

The New Jersey Laborers' Union in partnership with the Jersey City Employment and Training Program and the City of Jersey City is recruiting qualified minorities to join the Laborers' Union Apprenticeship Program.

Applicants must:

- Be a resident of Jersey City
- Be African American, Latino, Native American or Asian
- Be at least 18 years of age
- Be physically able to perform the work of the trade.
- Possess a valid and current driver's license to qualify for this class.
Individuals without a driver's license may qualify for a future class.
- Pass a drug test.
- Have an 8th grade reading and math level

The program entails an intensive two-week training in Jamesburg followed by two years of full-time work at a union wage. These two years will include 400 hours of related classroom instruction in Jamesburg.
